## Philosophy

At Country Day, we, as a community of learners, seek to develop confident and caring students with clear intellectual fortitude and a proclivity to question and explore change rather than avoid it.

- The Montessori philosophy begins with a deep respect for children as unique individuals.
- Montessori students develop self discipline and an internal sense of purpose and motivation.

## Unique Characteristics of Montessori Education

- Classrooms typically have a 2-3 year age range.
- Montessori teaches children to think, collaborate, and to discover.
- Classroom materials—a road from the concrete to the abstract.
- Classrooms organized in several curriculum areas: practical life, sensorial, language, mathematics, geography and science.
- Children take responsibility for their own education, giving them the opportunity to make choices.
- Classrooms provide a prepared environment where children are free to respond to their natural tendency to work.
