## “Creative Movement”

Classical Ballet & Traditional Tap Curriculum  
Appropriately modified for Preschoolers

**Ballet Objective:** Dancers will develop proper posture and technique. They will learn and understand the basic positions and steps that define ballet (1st through 5th positions, plea, releve, pique, tondu, echappe, saute, and reverence) as well as discipline and performance qualities that go into the performing arts.

**Tap Objective:** Dancers will learn the basic tap steps (such as the difference between right and left, toe drops, heel drop, shuffle step, shuffle hop step, ball change, flaps) and develop the articulation of sounds. Lots of fun for the feet!

**Dress Code:** Pink Tights, Black or Purple Leotard, Ballet Shoes and Tap Shoes. (Please label shoes & clothes.)
