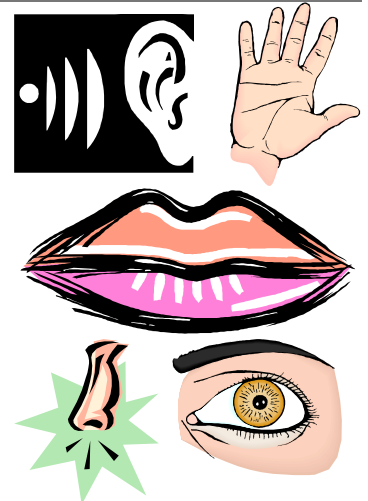
## CDSA Summer Fun!
